This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for handing over the investigation in a case bearing FIR No.73 dated 15.09.2022 under Sections 22/29 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Aur, District SBS Nagar, Punjab (Annexure P-1) to some independent agency like Central Bureau of Investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case, he is permitted to file a representation to the concerned Inspector General of Police, Crime Branch and the said representation be decided within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, petitioner is permitted to file a representation to the concerned Inspector General of Police, Crime Branch and in case, such representation is filed, the concerned IGP, decide the same within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the representation, by passing a speaking and reasoned order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, liberty is reserved to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

The present petition is partly allowed to the extent above.
