The present application has been filed for dismissal of the main case praying for quashing of the FIR as the petitioners have not complied with their part of compromise.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the main case is taken up on board for consideration today itself.

CRM-M-43853-2019

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer for quashing of the FIR No.446, dated 13.09.2019, under Sections 406, 420 & 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated

19.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as for respondent No.2 have stated that after the initial compromise was effected between the parties, the statements were also got recorded before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court. However, the compromise has not been honoured by the parties.

Both the learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.2 have stated that they have ascertained this factual position from their respective parties.

In view of the aforesaid position, since the present petition is for quashing of the FIR based upon compromise only and the parties have resiled from the compromise, the subject matter of the present petition does not survive. Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

Since the main petition has been dismissed, therefore, all the pending applications stand disposed of.
