The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 21.03.2020 under Sections 302, 201, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mukandpur, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail and was regularly attending the court proceedings, however, she could not appear before the trial Court on 09.12.2021 and her bail/surety bonds have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against her.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for grant of fresh bail.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court will release her on bail, subject to her furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioner appears before the trial Court, her arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 5,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, S.B.S. Nagar.
