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Vide these applications, advancement of the date of hearing in the
accompanying petitions is sought, on the ground that a co-accused of the

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applicants-petitioners, i.e. their mother, Gurinder Kaur, has been admitted to bail by this court vide an order passed on 07.12.2021 in CRM-M-31331 of 2021.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice at the asking of the court.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, both the applications are allowed for the aforesaid reasons and the date of hearing in both the accompanying petitions is advanced to today itself.

Learned counsel for the State also received the brief of both the cases and has gone through the same.

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Vide these petitions, the petitioners seek the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.08, dated 03.02.2021, having been registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 302, 148, 149 and 201 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners having been attributed blows with hockey sticks on the legs and arms of the deceased Satpal Singh, with the complainant still to be examined, they do not deserve to be admitted to bail.

Counsel for the petitioners on the other hand submit that the blows attributed to the mother of the petitioners, Gurinder Kaur, were also on the non-

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vital parts of the body of the deceased and that in fact the fatal blows (as alleged), were attributed to Swaran Singh, who is alleged to have given iron rod blows on the head of Satpal Singh, due to which he fell down.

He further submits that the trial not having made much progress and the petitioners having been in custody for about more than 1 year now, they may be admitted to bail.

Having considered the above, looking at the role attributed to the petitioners and with their co-accused (their mother) having been attributed a some what similar role though with a different weapon of offence, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.

A copy of this order be also placed on the file of the other connected matter.
