DEEPAK MANCHANDA J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to conduct investigation with regard to incident dated 26.07.2022 and to hand over the investigation to an independent agency or to some other Police Station other than Police Station Sadar, Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) and further seeking directions to respondent Nos. 2 to decide the representation dated 25.08.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that petitioner has sent a representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) regarding the inaction of the police in the matter and would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No. 2 to take a decision on the same after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ferry Sofat, Addl. AG Punjab who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 5.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and with a direction to the respondent authorities to decide the representation/complaint dated 25.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) and to pass an appropriate order thereupon, within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
