Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.99 dated 17.06.2018, registered for offences under Sections 323, 452, 354, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 21.06.2018, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Although, report has been received from the Trial Court, but examination of the allegations levelled in the FIR shows that there are two victims, namely, Satya Devi and Rohit, both of whom are neither party to the compromise nor impleaded in the present petition.

In the absence of both the victims, prayer made in the petition cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case a fresh compromise is entered into between all the parties.
