The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for directing respondents to release the retiral benefit of the father of petitioners No. 1 and 2 and husband of the petitioner No. 3 and to stop illegal interest on the amounts shown due, for which, legal notice dated 24.09.2021 has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, the

directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
