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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through VideoConferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to submit a comprehensive representation in respect of grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition to respondent No.7 and directions being issued to respondent No.7 to consider and decide the representation in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.7.

[4] Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.7 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

[5] In view of the nature of order proposed to be passed, no reply is necessary.

[6] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon

the merits of the case, the writpetition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.7 within one week from date of receipt of certified copy of order. In case, any such representation is received by respondent No.7, the same be considered and decided in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.
