The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty, which according to the petitioner is a threat at the hands of respondent No.4, who is the husband of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner is living separately from respondent No.4 in a rented accommodation but, respondent No.4 is not only harassing her but is also humiliating her in front of the locality where she is living and has also issued threat regarding her life and liberty. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the said grievance has already been brought to the notice of the Police authorities vide representations dated 13.12.2021 (Annexures P-1&2), which are still pending consideration with the said authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 &3 to decide the said representations by passing

an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karan Garg, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that the representations dated 13.12.2021 (Annexures P-1&2) submitted by the petitioner will be decided within a period of eight weeks from today and in case, after the decision, it is found that any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken without any further delay.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent Nos.2 & 3 are directed to decide representations dated 13.12.2021 (Annexures P-1&2) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
