The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction for quashing the impugned condition No.11 of appointment letters (Annexure P-10) dated 24.10.2018), issued by respondent to the petitioners whereby the petitioners were not permitted to take notional benefit of their relevant previous experience rendered as Master/Mistresses under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan for any purpose.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, the petitioners would be satisfied in case, the representation dated 25.11.2021 (Annexure P-15) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Secretary, Department of School Education, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 25.11.2021 (Annexure P-15), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
