On an application filed by respondent No.4, a demolished water course was ordered to be restored. Appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the finding of the Courts below that a water course has been demolished is factually incorrect. The said water course irrigates the land of the petitioner as is evident from site plan (Annexure P-7) and thus, there was no question of him having demolished his own water course.

Assuming, that the argument is correct, order of restoration does not adversely affect the interest of the petitioner. Thus, the same cannot be accepted.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
