This appeal has been filed against the order dated 05.08.2021 passed by Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, whereby interim maintenance of Rs.1,25,000/- per month has been awarded from the date of filing of the application to the minor child who was to undergo medical treatment or surgery.

The marriage between the parties was solemnized on 10.12.2005 as per Hindu Rites and Ceremonies at Ashoka Hotel, Bhopal. Out of the said wedlock, one son namely Shaurya Raj Singh was later born in the year 2013. On account of temperamental differences, the parties could not stay together and are residing separately since 1.4.2020.

During the pendency of this appeal, the parties have entered

into a compromise which is taken on record as Annexure A-1 dated 29.03.2022 and the same has been duly signed by both the parties. Their Aadhar cards are on record as Annexures A-2 and A-3. Both the parties have also got their statements recorded in Court today. As per their statements, they shall remain bound by and undertake to comply with the terms of the settlement agreement (Annexure A-1) dated 29.03.2022.

In view of the above, this appeal is being disposed of.
