Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.198 dated 27.09.2020, registered under Sections 22, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Mokhampura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 05.04.2022 of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar City, submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is marginally above the commercial quantity; that at one stage, the petitioner was granted interim bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, till the receipt of the FSL

report; that after receipt of the FSL report, the petitioner himself surrendered on 13.08.2021 and that the petitioner has been in custody since 13.08.2021.

Learned State counsel, while opposing the prayer for bail, submits that one more FIR No.231/2018 under NDPS Act is also registered and pending against the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The recovery effected from the petitioner is marginally above the commercial quantity and he is involved in one another case under NDPS Act. As the petitioner is involved in another case under NDPS Act, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of regular bail to him.

The petition is dismissed.
