The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No. 163, dated 22.06.2018, under Section 376 of IPC, registered at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar Mohali (annexed as Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 17.12.2021 (annexed as Annexures P-4 & P-5 respectively), having been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to satisfy this Court as to how the FIR which stands registered for an offence under Section 376 IPC, can be quashed on the basis of a compromise. The prosecution evidence, as submitted by the learned counsel is already underway before the learned trial Court.

In the circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to exercise its inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the FIR in question.

Dismissed.
