Bar is abstaining from work.

Through instant petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking bail in FIR No.9 dated 20.01.2018 registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar under Section 22 (Challan present under Section 21) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

As per record, the petitioner in aforesaid FIR was arrested on 20.01.2018 and thereafter released on interim bail on 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-2). Interim bail was made absolute on 02.05.2018 (Annexure P-3). The petitioner was declared Proclaimed Offender vide order dated 08.01.2019 and thereafter arrested on 28.07.2022. Since then, the petitioner is in custody. The petitioner filed an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. before Judge Special Court, Rupnagar seeking regular bail which came to be dismissed vide order dated 08.09.2022 (Annexure P-4).

ASI Avtar Singh, who is present in Court does not dispute

the above narrated facts and leaves to this Court to pass an appropriate

orders.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances as noted above, period of custody and the fact that the petitioner was initially released on interim bail and thereafter interim bail was confirmed, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.
