Present petition has been filed by the petitioner raising a claim that in case the petitioner is to be transferred under the category of “anywhere” the petitioner should have been asked for option.

The claim of the petitioner is that without seeking the option of the petitioner, the petitioner has been posted which is contrary to the transfer policy. Second prayer of the petitioner is that he has already raised his claim in the representation dated 07.09.2022 (Annrxure P-5) and thereafter, vide legal notice dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents, hence, the respondents be

directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioner expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
