When confronted with the allegations levelled in the FIR, the statement of the minor prosecutrix recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. as well as the observations of the Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh versus Laxmi Narayan and others (2019) 5 SCC 688**, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
