By this petition, filed under the provisions of Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the “action” of the respondents in not considering their applications dated 15.10.2008 (Annexures P-3 to P-5) and 29.07.2015 (Annexure P-16), already pending with earnest money deposited for the draw of lots conducted, in compliance of the public notice dated 04.09.2018, which was challenged in CWP No.19304 of 2020 and eight other writ petitions, with counsel for the respondents even having admitted (as contended) regarding certain discrepancies and infirmities in the draw of lots and the proceedings of the screening committee due to which a fresh draw of lots was to be conducted qua the applicants; with them having submitted applications in compliance of the said public notice dated 04.09.2018. Therefore, it is alleged that the applications of the petitioners were wrongly and illegally not included in the list of the

eligible/successful applicants for the draw of lots under the oustees category (as contended). The petitioners have further prayed for directions to the respondents to consider their old applications, or to grant them an opportunity to submit fresh applications if required, to fulfill the eligibility condition for allotment of plots in the oustee category.

At the outset itself, learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that the issue involved in this petition is covered by the decision of this court dated 01.04.2022 passed in CWP No.13733 of 2020 (Ramesh Chand Vs. State of Haryana and others).

That being so, this petition is also disposed of in the same terms as CWP No.13733 of 2020.
