Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has cleared the written examination for selection and appointment to the post of TGT (English) as advertised vide advertisement No.09.2015 but the petitioner could not appear for the scrutiny of documents and consequential interview as the petitioner was not in a good health. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though the selection has been finalized but 05 posts are still lying vacant in the category, in which, the petitioner is competing i.e. reserved category of BCA, as no candidate has been found suitable to be selected and appointed on the said posts. Prayer of the petitioner is that as the posts are still lying vacant and petitioner has already cleared the written examination, the respondents are under an obligation to call the petitioner for scrutiny of documents and consequential interview.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing

a representation dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief, which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
