1. This order shall decide COCP-3488-2019, COCP-3491-2019, COCP-3494-2019 and COCP-3498-2019, as common point is in issue in all the cases. Facts of the case are being taken from COCP-3488-2019.

Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful breach of undertaking/statement, Annexure P/1 dated 20.03.2018 and Annexure P/2 dated 28.11.2018, made before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram, in CNR No.HRGR-03-006396-2016 (138NI/3672/2016).

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner (s) states that in view of fresh settlement having been entered into between the parties before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram, in supersession of agreement dated 18.12.2017 and the parties having agreed to remain bound by the terms and conditions of the fresh agreement, the petitioner(s) is not interested in pursuing the instant

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petitions are *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
