[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 23.12.2020 in CRM-M-43675-2020.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 23.12.2020 reveals that CRM-M-43675-2020 was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to look into and decide representation dated 13.12.2019 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned Counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the needful.

[4] Learned AAG, Punjab has produced order dated **05.02.2021** deciding representation dated 13.12.2019 filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 05.02.2021 passed in compliance or order dated 23.12.2020 in CRM-M-43675-2020, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but petitioner

appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel.

[6] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.02.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
