RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) as well as
respondent(s) submit that the issue involved in these petition stands
concluded and decided by the Supreme Court in **Civil Appeal 603 of 2020**
(Union of India Vs. Federation of Self-Finance Ayurvedic Colleges
Punjab and others), wherein the Supreme Court has upheld the decision of
the authorities but, while doing so, has regularized the admission given to

large number of students as an interim measure by various High Courts for 2019-2020 session provided that such admissions were granted prior to the last date of admission i.e. 15.10.2019 for under graduate courses and 31.10.2019 for post-graduate courses.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that these petitions are squarely covered by the decision of the Supreme Court and may be disposed of in the similar terms.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties as well as the decision of the Supreme Court (ibid), these petitions are disposed of in the similar terms.
