Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to refix the pay of petitioner by restoring the benefits of promotional increments.

In pursuance of the notice of motion issued by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sandesh Raj, Executive Engineer, Store, Purchase & Disposal Division, Shahpurkandi Township, Tehsil and District Pathankot, has been filed. Para No.6 of the same reads as under:-

“That the claim of the petitioner has already been reconsidered and accordingly his pay has been refixed by restoring his special increments alongwith one promotional increment by enhancing his basic pay from Rs.1020/- to Rs.1055/- which is admissible to the petitioner. Copy of Revision of pay chart dated 04.10.2021 is annexed as Annexure R-1.”

Perusal of above extract makes it abundantly clear that benefit

of increments has been restored to the petitioner and his pay is refixed from ₹1020/- to ₹1055/-.

In view of the above, this Court is satisfied that grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and the instant petition is rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved, he would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
