Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the representation filed by the petitioner against the order of transfer has been rejected by the respondents by taking into consideration the facts, which are incorrect hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to re-consider the claim of the petitioner qua the transfer afresh by taking into consideration the relevant and correct facts.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit that the order dated 29.09.2022 (Annexure P-12) by which representation of the petitioner has been decided, be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the respondents to pass a fresh order on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 29.09.2022 (Annexure P-12) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to pass a fresh order and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.

In case, the petitioner has not been relieved so far, keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 20559 of 2022 dated 09.09.2022 vide which the petitioner was allowed to continue till the decision of his representation, as the said representation is now to be decided afresh, the petitioner be allowed to continue at the present place of posting in case, he was not relieved as on 09.09.2022.
