This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of regular bail, in case FIR No.147 dated 19.12.2020 registered for offence under Section 22 (c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda, Punjab.

Custody Certificate dated 07.01.2022 has been filed by the State, which is taken on record.

When confronted with fact that a huge recovery of 8500 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride, weighing 2.759 kg approximately, has been recovered from the petitioner, who was posted as a Head Constable with Haryana Police and is the owner as well as the driver of the vehicle from which recovery has been effected, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
