It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had made the following representations seeking refund of excess pre-paid taxes along with statutory interest under Section 244 A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 arising pursuant to assessment orders under Section 143(3) of the said Act for the assessment year 2013-2014 and assessment year 2010-2011.

It is contended that none of these representations have been disposed of by respondent No.1 and the inaction has caused serious prejudice to the petitioner.

Mr. Tejinder Joshi, Advocate appearing for respondent No.1, on instructions, states that respondent No.1 will take an appropriate decision, as per law, on the said representations within a period of 4 weeks and communicate his decision to the petitioner.

Therefore, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take a decision on the refund of excess pre-paid taxes along with statutory interest to the petitioner for the said assessment years made pursuant to the said representations made by the petitioner, within a period of 4 weeks and communicate his decision to the petitioner.
