Challenge in this appeal is to the order dated 20.02.2020 passed by the learned Single Judge, wherein, the writ petition has been dismissed on the ground that the petitioner had not agitated the issue with regard to he being proceeded against *ex parte* illegally before the subordinate authorities or before the Revisional Authority, and even before the learned Single Judge, nothing was placed on record which would substantiate the contention that he has been wrongly proceeded against *ex parte* by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade in the partition proceedings.

Appellant has moved an application i.e. CM-169-LPA-2022 for additional evidence along with the present appeal with an intent to place on record the service report on the summons of the Assistant Collector 1st

Grade, Fazilka (Annexure A-1) and the expert report regarding signatures of the petitioner on the summons (Annexure A-2). The said prayer with regard to the production of the said documents as Annexures A-1 and A-2 cannot be accepted at this stage especially when this was never agitated or placed on record before the Financial Commissioner or the learned Single Judge. In any case, we do not find any merit in the present appeal and therefore, refuse to interfere in the present appeal.

The present appeal as well as CM-169-LPA-2022, therefore, stand dismissed.
