Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.263 dated 29.09.2019 under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

On 06.01.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel contends that though the concession of interim pre arrest bail was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-48186-2019, but as he failed to join the investigation pursuant to the said order, his bail application was dismissed in August, 2021. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is willing to settle the dispute with the complainant and would make the payment of Rs.6,50,000/- to him.

Notice of motion for 13.01.2022.

Let the complainant be impleaded as respondent No.2.

The petitioner is directed to bring the demand draft for a sum of Rs.6,50,000/- in the name of the complainant on the next date of hearing.

Till the next date, the arrest of the petitioner shall

remain stayed.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner is a poor person and cannot deposit the above mentioned amount.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, who has retracted from his stand, this Court is not inclined to entertain the second bail petition on merits.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
