The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 397 dated 09.10.2020, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

The operative part of the order dated 22.12.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is only a Registration Clerk and on the disclosure of co-accused Subhash Chander, the name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case.

Notice of motion for 07.04.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 22.12.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from DSP Vivek Chaudhary, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the challan stands presented and petitioner has joined the investigation and is no

more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 22.12.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
