The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.246 dated 01.10.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 354 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, district Tarn Taran.

On 23.12.2021, this Court had passed the following order : -

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.246 dated 01.10.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 354 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it was on account of a trivial dispute between the parties and some misunderstanding, the FIR in question came to be registered, however, subsequently the parties amicably resolved their dispute and arrived at a settlement vide

Annexure P-1 dated 03.11.2021. Learned counsel submits that a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has also been preferred before this Court by the parties seeking quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of compromise in which notice of motion has been issued (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

At this stage, Mr. Parminder Singh, Advocate for Mr. Jagjit Singh, Advocate has put in an appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and he undertakes to file power of attorney in the Registry of this Court. Learned counsel does not dispute the submissions made by the counsel opposite.

Learned State counsel seeks time to complete her instructions.

Adjourned to 10.03.2022.

Meanwhile, petitioners-Jatinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh @ Babba, Avtar Singh and Baldev Singh are directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the

petitioners in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the State, the interim order of this Court dated 23.12.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is ordered to be made absolute.
