The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 78 dated 04.08.2019, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail and was facing the trial, however, the petitioner noted a wrong date as 28.10.2021, whereas the correct date was 08.10.2021, therefore, he could not appear before the trial Court on 08.10.2021.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and apply for grant of fresh bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no serious objection to the prayer made by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sher Singh, submits that

the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court shall release him on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court, his arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to deposit of cost of Rs. 3,000/- by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar.
