While assailing the correctness of the order dated 7th December, 2018 passed by the Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division, Phagwara, the petitioner (mother of minor Arman) has filed the present petition. The court has permitted the grandparents of Arman to meet him for a period of two hours on every third Saturday of the month between 2 p.m. to 4 p.m, at Mediation and Conciliation Centre, District Courts Kapurthala.

Heard the learned counsel representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the child is residing with his mother at Phagwara whereas the court has provided visitation rights to the grandparents at District Courts, Kapurthala. He submits that the visitation rights can be given at Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Jalandhar, which is nearby. He further contends that the child has to attend his school on every 3rd

Saturday, therefore, the visitation rights, if required to be given, be shifted to second Saturday of every month instead of 3rd Saturday.

Learned counsel representing the respondent has no objection thereto.

In view of the aforesaid, the impugned order dated 7th December, 2018 is modified. The petitioner is directed to bring the child Arman to meet his grandparents at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, District Court, Jalandhar, on every second Saturday of the month, between 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

With all these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
