The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.258 dated 27.09.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B (Section 120-B only mentioned in the impugned order not in FIR) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ambala Sadar, District Ambala

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the whole amount has been paid to the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of order dated 17.11.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant admits the fact that the complainant has received the whole amount from the petitioner.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.11.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
