In the instant petition, a prayer is made for a mandamus being issued upon co-respondent Nos.2 and 3 to make a decision in accordance with law, upon the petitioner's representations dated 09.11.2021 and 10.11.202 (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

Though this Court would have directed respondent Nos.1 to 3 to make a speaking decision within a time-bound manner, upon the petitioner's representations (Annexures P-1 and P-2), however, learned State counsel submits that after an inquiry made upon Annexures P-1 and P-2, the Inquiry Officer has directed the initiation of proceedings under Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. against the accused concerned.

Therefore, in view of the above made statement at the bar, the

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instant petition does not survive and is disposed of as such.

However, liberty is yet reserved to the petitioner to recourse all available remedies, in accordance with law. Moreover, if any life endangering threat is meted to the petitioner by the private respondents, thereupon, it is open for the petitioner to make a petition before the authorities concerned, and the latter, on receiving the petition concerned, shall in accordance with law, make a speaking decision thereon.
