For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed
as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

MAIN CASE

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution for quashing the action of respondents while not allowing revised
pay scale of Rs.4020-6200 to the petitioner from the date his services were
regularized w.e.f. 18.05.2001, along with all consequential benefits.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, her client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 23.02.2021 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 23.02.2021 (P-10) by passing reasoned order as per law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
