1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CWP-3946-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-3946-2022, was disposed of vide order dated 02.03.2022, by directing the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, C-Block, Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar, to decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 13.08.2021 served by him, within four months.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has filed compliance report along with speaking order Annexure R-2/1, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 13.08.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that in view of needful having been done and the claim of the petitioner having been decided, no action is called for against respondent No.2 under the

Contempt of Courts At, 1971.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R-2/1 dated 29.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
