Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.0109 dated 03.12.2021 registered under Section 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station Garhdiwal, District Hoshiarpur, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 23.12.2021, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel contends that as per allegations, complainant had paid a sum of Rs.1 lac to the petitioner for getting job in Punjab Tubewell Corporation, but according to him, the allegations are vague and lack all kinds of particulars. He submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated, who is ready to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Amarjit Singh,

required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2021 is made absolute.
