[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, dated 15.05.2019 and 30.05.2019, in CWP-PIL No.108 of 2019 in case titled as '**Om Parkash**versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-PIL No.108 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitionerby passing appropriate orders in respect thereto in accordance with law within two months.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that since orders have been passed by the respondents in terms of order Annexure P-1, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
