On 05.01.2022, the following order had been passed by this court:-

“Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.93, dated 17.5.2019, having been registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 379-B of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that ever since the petitioner was admitted to bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide his order dated 1.7.2019, he was regularly appearing before the court and only on a single occasion, i.e. on 2.11.2021, he did not appear before that court, leading to cancellation of his bail and surety bonds.

Notice of motion.

Mr.M.S.Nagra, learned AAG, Punjab, accepts notice at the asking of the court.

Though the excuse given by learned counsel for the petitioner for his not appearing on that date is the usual one, i.e. he had noted the wrong date to appear before the court, however even while not fully believing that contention, yet looking at his past conduct to the effect that he had been coming present before the trial court on every date except for one, he is directed to surrender

before the learned trial court within one week from today and upon him so doing, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of that court, till the next date of hearing before this court.

Adjourned to 21.2.2022.”

Learned State counsel submits that, as per his instructions from HC Bohar Singh, the petitioner surrendered before the trial court and has been admitted to interim bail by that court.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the order dated 05.01.2022 made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
