Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the setting aside of the order dated 19.10.2021 passed by the learned Principal Judge (Family Court), Nuh, in MNT 72/2018, vide which he has been summoned through conditional warrants. He further seeks a stay on the operation of the aforesaid order.

However, at the outset itself, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact he does not press that prayer and instead seeks that the revision filed by him against the order of the learned Addl. CJM, Nuh, dated 12.04.2019 (copy Annexure P-1), be decided by the revisional court within a fixed time frame, that petition (copy Annexure P-2) shown to have been filed on 13.05.2019.

any manner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the revisional court to pass an appropriate order on merits as it deems best, in the said petition, within a period of two months from today, if it has not already done so.
