[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.08.2022, in CWP No.17119 of 2022 in case titled as '**Parvesh Kumar @ Parvesh Aggarwal versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.17119 of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 05.08.2022 by directing respondent No.3 in the instant petition to consider pending representation dated 06.04.2022 and to pass appropriate orders on the same in accordance with law, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if the claim of the petitioner was established with reference to the record, then the benefits admissible were to be released to the petitioner forthwith.

[3] Compliance report-cum-reply dated 12.12.2022 has been filed

by way of affidavit of respondent No.3. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of decision of representation dated 06.04.2022 and payment of the amount as claimed by the petitioner as per his entitlement, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
