The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7.

As per the petitioner, the allegations against him are that vehicle of respondent No.6 is in his possession and the same has not been returned to its registered owner, due to which, an FIR has been registered against the petitioner.

Petitioner has submitted that he has no concern with the said allegations and the vehicle is not in his possession and he is being falsely implicated by respondent No.6.

From the pleadings it transpires that the petitioner has already brought the said grievance into the notice of respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur by way of filing a

representation dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P/1), which is still pending consideration with the said respondent.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that the representation dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioner will be decided expeditiously and in case, after the decision, it is found that any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken without any further delay.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P/1), respondent No.3 is directed to decide representation dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
