The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 16.11.2021 and to fix the pension, to pay all retrial benefits; arrear of Monthly Financial Assistance from 18.02.2009 to 17.02.2021 along with interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payment as per the judgment of the Apex Court reported as 2001(9) SCC 687, along with certain other prayers.

In view of the facts of the case and the prayers made by the petitioner, it would be appropriate if the respondents take a final decision qua the claim of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner, as prayed for by the counsel in the petition.

In view of the above, respondent No.2 is directed to take a conscious decision upon representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-2), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
