1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-3, dated 26.07.2021, in CWP-13483-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-3 dated 26.07.2021, reveals that CWP-13483-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 27.12.2019, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has filed short reply by way of affidavit of the respondent stating therein that claim of the petitioner has been decided vide order dated 08.11.2021, and payment on account of overtime has been released to the petitioner whereas vide order dated 22.07.2022, interest @ 9 % p.a. on delayed payment of overtime of Rs.1,83,273/-has been approved and an amount of Rs.1,95,186/- released to the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the

petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
