The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking directions to the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge Sangrur to decide Criminal Appeal bearing No. CRA-93-2020 within time bound manner.

Counsel for the petitioner-complainant submits that the complainant has a right to speedy disposal of trial which has been guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. The complaint preferred by the petitioner was instituted on 24.05.2017 and the same culminated in order of conviction passed against the respondent dated 06.02.2020. Respondent-accused preferred appeal against the same which was instituted on 05.03.2020. He further submits that thereafter the matter is being repeatedly adjourned on the false representation made by the accused submitting that there were chances of amicable settlement. He submits that it is a fit case where the direction be issued for the speedy disposal of the present appeal.

In view of the innocuous prayer made by the counsel for the

petitioner, I find that it will be in the interest of both the parties that the appeal pending be disposed of expeditiously. Resultantly, Appellate Court is directed to decide the appeal expeditiously preferably within 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the nature of the prayer made in the petition, this Court does not find it necessary to issue notice to the respondents. However, in case, the respondent No.1 feels aggrieved of the order, he is at liberty to move an appropriate application seeking recalling or modification of the order.

Disposed of accordingly.
