The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representation dated 13.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) given by the petitioner against respondents No.5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, would submit that for his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 13.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Director Village Development and Department of Panchayat i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Balbir Singh Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He would submit that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Director Village Development and Department of Panchayat, to take a decision on the representation dated 13.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
