On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

'Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Gurmeet Singh, BDPO, Ferozepur, states that neither any allotment letter has been issued in favour of respondents No.8 to 18 nor has the possession been handed over to them and, therefore, the assertions in the writ petition are not correct. Counsel states that an affidavit to this effect will be filed within a period of one week.

In pursuance thereto, affidavit dated 04.04.2022, of the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ferozepur, Punjab has been filed, wherein in Para-5 of the said affidavit it has been stated as follows:-

'That, in this regard, it is submitted that as per the record available in the office of the answering deponent, no allotment letter has ever been issued in favour of respondents No.8 to 18 and the possession has also not been handed over to the private respondents No.8 to 18.'
