Vide order dated 10.01.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Further, the petitioner has also deposited a sum of Rs.1,20,000/- in the account of Joga Ram in view of the order dated 14.03.2022.

3. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail. He further submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

4. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 10.01.2022, is hereby made absolute.
