The petitioner has applied for a mutation on the basis of Will. A counter-Will has been set by the private respondents, which is being looked into by respondent No.2.

It is submitted that the Will relied upon by the private respondents does not have any legal sanctity as suit filed on the basis thereof has been dismissed for non-prosecution. Thus, respondent No.2 may be directed not to take the same into consideration while passing an order.

The prayer cannot be accepted. Respondent No.2 has jurisdiction to decide a contested mutation and no direction can be issued to restrain him from carrying on his statutory duty.

In view of the above, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
