The challenge is to the order passed by the Reference Court while refusing to detag/segregate the petitioner's case from a totally unconnected bunch of cases.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that his case is related to the acquisition of land for development of Sector 10, Jhajjar and the main bunch belongs to cases arising from acquisition of land for development of Sector 7. The Reference Court has refused to detag the case on the ground that it was tagged 5 years back with the bunch of cases but the petitioner never objected.

Notice of motion.

At the request of the Court, Mr. Harsh Vardhan Shehrawat, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana.

Once, it has come to the notice of the Court that the petitioner's case has been wrongly tagged with an unconnected batch of cases then it is the duty of the court to correct that particular mistake.

The court is required to see as to whether all the cases, which have been

consolidated, are under a batch of same/common acquisition or connected with the lead case or not. Hence, the impugned order is set aside. The Reference Court is directed to detag the case from the batch of cases relating to acquisition of land for development of Sector 10, Jhajjar and tag with the bunch of case arising from acquisition of land for development of Sector 7, Jhajjar. Consequently, the order dated 07.10.2022 is set aside.

The revision petition stands allowed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
